– Steady Progress of Bilateral Economic Cooperation –

On May 21, 2024, the Saudi-Japan Vision 2030 Business Forum was jointly hosted by the Ministry of Investment for Saudi Arabia, the Ministry of Economy, Trade, and Industry (METI) of Japan, the Japan External Trade Organization (JETRO), and JCCME in Tokyo.

H.R.H. Prince Abdulaziz bin Salman, Minister of Energy; H.E. Eng. Khalid bin Abdulaziz Al-Falih, Minister of Investment; H.E. Eng. Abdullah Alswaha, Minister of Communications and Information Technology; and other Saudi government representatives attended this forum from Saudi Arabia. METI Minister Saito Ken also participated in the forum. The event gathered many participants from government agencies and companies of both Saudi Arabia and Japan.

At this forum, panel discussions that focused on manufacturing, the circular economy, the entertainment and gaming industry, and healthcare industry were held. The results of bilateral collaborative efforts were displayed and participants exchanged their opinions there. A photo session was simultaneously held in the event to unveil memorandums of understanding (MOUs) between Saudi government agencies and Japanese companies.

Kodaira Nobuyori, President of JCCME delivered a speech presenting the results of JCCME's collaborative efforts and their current status to accelerate Japanese companies' investment in Saudi Arabia.
